CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the Appellate Authority vide Order No.F.No.42-138/2001Appeal/20216 dated 19.04.2002 reversed the Order appealed against and granted recognition to St. Jude's College of Education for Women, Vikarabad, Ranga Reddy, Andhra Pradesh with an annual intake of B.Ed. course of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dated 19.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 31.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.


3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in 381st meeting held on 31st Oct & 1st Nov, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN In all such matters where the institution has not submitted requisite documents/VT Reports accompanied with requisite documents in respond to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly, First Show Cause was issued on 25.11.2019. The management of the institution submitted reply vide letter dated 11.01.2020 to the First Show Cause Notice.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 384th meeting held on 12th to 13th February 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice. Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 11.03.2020. The management of the institution submitted its reply vide letter dated 20.03.2020 to the Final Show Cause Notice.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the mater was further considered by the SRC in its meeting 388th held on 14th - 15th September 2020 and the committee decided to issue Last Reminder Letter. Accordingly, a Last Reminder Letter was issued to the institution on 24.09.2020 the institution management of the was submitted reply on 22.10.2020.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 410th meeting held on 25th & 26th April 2022 considered the matter and decided to withdraw the recognition. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Withdrawal order was issued to the institution vide order no. F.SRO/NCTE/APS00017/B.Ed./TS /2022/133043-133046 dated 27.07.2022.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has filed Writ Petition before Hon'ble High Court of Delhi for bearing W.P (C) No. 15040/2022 & CM APPLs. 46432/2022 titled as St Judes College of Education Versus National Council for Teacher Education Whereby the Hon'ble High Court has directed that :-

13. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **St. Jude's College of Education for Women, Survey No. 15 (103), Ward No.6, Vikarabad, Ranga Reddy District- 501101, Telangana** for continuation of recognition for **B.Ed. Programme** for two years duration (1 basic unit) of 50 students subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-


- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

14. Further, the Institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

15. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self - Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

16. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter - alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter:
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;



- e. Fee charged from students;
- f. Available Infrastructural facilities;
- g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.


17. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

19. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.



ORDER

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993(73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 1.12.2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, the institution, **St.Judes College of Education for Women, C/o St. Judes High School Vikarabad, Ranga Reddy -501101, Andhra Pradesh** has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for two basic units in **100** which require additional facilities

3. AND WHEREAS, it has been decided to permit the institution to have two basic units of 50 students each subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely,

- I The institution shall submit all the documents and FDRs of the existing course including recognition order issued earlier and the latest affiliation order by 30.06.2015.
- ii The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) additional staff as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015
- iii The applicant-institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC), Building Plan (BP) and the Approved Staff List in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building Completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting team at the time of inspection.
- IV The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 Feb, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017

4. NOW THEREFORE, in the light of the above and in terms of Section 14(3) of NCTE Act and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **St.Judes College of Education for Women, C/o St. Judes High School Vikarabad, Ranga Reddy -501101, Andhra Pradesh** for conducting B.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of **100** students each for two basic units from the academic session **2015-16** subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned herein before 31.10.2015

5. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

ORDER

WHEREAS the Southern Regional Committee, National Council for Teacher Education, Bangalore in its Order No. F. AP/New/B.Ed/74/SRO/NCTE/2001-2002/8463 dated the 5th November, 2001 (hereinafter referred to as the Order) refused recognition to **St. Jude's College of Education for Women, Vikarabad, Ranga Reddy District-501101, A.P.** for conducting B.Ed. Course on the ground that of the staff list containing 7 names submitted by the institution, 2 lecturers had already joined another college and the institution does not have 10 qualified lecturers for an intake of 120 students.

AND WHEREAS the Correspondent, St. Jude's College of Education for Women, Vikarabad (hereinafter referred to as the Appellant) preferred an appeal dated the 28th November, 2001 to the National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as the Council) under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the said Order.

AND WHEREAS the appeal of the appellant institution was considered by the Council in its meeting held on 10th January, 2002 and Order No.42-138/2001-Appeal dated the 5th January, 2002 was issued asking the institution to submit a copy of the press notification for appointment of teachers, proceedings of the selection committee, transcripts and acceptance letters of selected candidates for further consideration of the appeal. The institution with its letter dated the 14th February, 2002, submitted various documents relating to the appointment of teaching staff.

AND WHEREAS the Council, after careful consideration of all aspects of the matter, in its meeting held on the 19th March 2002, has come to the conclusion that in view of the appointment of additional teaching staff by the institution subsequent to the consideration of the application by the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE, Bangalore, the appellant institution is **granted** recognition with an intake of 100 for the academic session for which admissions to the B Ed. Course are yet to be made. Continuation of the recognition for the following academic session and revision in the intake within the limit fixed in the
